## 3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to carry out manual or semiautomatic operations of moulding of glass products from molten masses or glass tubes following the technical instructions and ensuring the quality and occupational safety of the operations. This general competence is divided into the following **skill units(UC)**:

- Shape glass products manually or semi-automatically by blowing (UC0643\_1).
- Shape glass products manually or semi-automatically by casting, pressing and centrifugation (UC0644\_1).
- Make glass products manually or semi automatically by moulding glass tubes (UC0645\_1).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Shaping glass manually and semi-automatically by blowing (MF0643\_1).
- Shaping glass manually and semi-automatically by casting, pressing and centrifugation (MF0644\_1).
- Shaping glass tubes manually and semi-automatically (MF0645\_1).
- Practical training at the workplace in production and manufacture of glass products manually and semi-automatically (MP0259).

(See legal basis for all learning outcomes information acquired by the holder of this Certificate in each MF).

As a reference, the learning outcomes include in the Practical training that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Participate in the operations of reception and unloading of recycled glass rods and glass tubes for the manufacture of glass, according to the working instructions and complying with the established environmental protection requirements.
- Participate in the development of machines and tools and carry out operations for the manufacture of glass products with manual or semi-automatic moulding of molten glass mass.
- Participate in the preparation of the equipment, tools and materials, and carry out operations for the manufacture of glass by tubes moulding and glass rods.
- Participate in the preparation of the equipment, tools and materials, and carry out operations for the finishing of glass products obtained by moulding of glass tubes.
- Carry out the operations for the annealing of glass products.
- Participate in the storing of glass products obtained by manual and semiautomatic moulding.
- Participate in the working processes of the company, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

#### 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in manufacturing companies of: hollow glass, glass for home and for decoration as well as Glass containers and products production for the pharmaceutical industry. The most relevant occupations and work positions are:

- Glassblower.
- Master glazier.
- Transformer of hollow glass by manual and semi-automatic procedures.
- Glass-blowers, cutters, grinders and finishers.
- Producer of containers, household and manual and semi-automatic ornamental glass articles.
- Producer of glass containers for the pharmaceutical industry.

#### 5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

##### **Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate**

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

##### **Level of the certificate**

The Professional Certificate Level 1 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 2 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

##### **Grading scale/Pass requirements**

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

##### **Access to next level of education/training**

This Professional Certificate Level 1 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 2 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

##### **Legal basis**

Royal Decree 714/2011, of May 20th, by which three professional certificates of the professional family "Glass and ceramics", include in the National Repertoire of professional certificates are established. (Appendix III, Code: VICI0109)

## 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

**Additional information:** Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
