# **3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES**

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to carry out manufacturing, decoration and moulding of glass products operations, following the technical instructions and ensuring the quality and occupational safety of the operations. This general competence is divided into the following **skills units**(UC):

- Carry out manual machining on glass products (UC0144\_1).
- Make decorations on glass products by surface applications (UC0145\_1).
- Do glass products by firing and fusing (UC0146\_1).
- Elaborate stained glass (UC0147\_1).

The professional skills are acquired through the learning outcomes defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Manual machining of glass products (MF0144\_1).
- Surface applications (MF0145\_1).
- Firing and fusing (MF0146\_1).
- Stained glasses (MF0147\_1).
- Practical training at the workplace in decoration and moulding of glass products (MP0266).

(See legal basis for all learning outcomes information acquired by the holder of this Certificate in each MF).

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Participate in the manual machining of glass products operations.
- Participate in the assembly, sealing and installation of glazing operations.
- Participate in mechanical operations of glass decoration.
- Participate in the operations of transformation of glass products by superficial applications.
- Participate in the operations of elaborations of glass products by thermoforming and fusing.
- Participate in the assembly, framing and installation of stained glass.
- Apply occupational safety, health and environmental protection regulations in the glass products decoration and moulding processes.
- Participate in the working processes of the company, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.



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### 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in companies dedicated to manufacturing and decoration of flat glass, containers, household items and ornaments. The most relevant occupations and work positions are:

- Glass decorator.
- Glass painter-decorator.
- Glass carver.
- Glass and crystal carvers.
- Ornamental flat glass moulder (thermoforming).
- Fusing operator.
- Glazier.
- Stained glass glazier.
- Blowers, modellers, glass cutters and polishers.
- Workers in the manufacturing of artistic glass in general.
- Glassblowers.
- Glass engravers.
- Glass screen printers.
- Painters in glass, ceramics and other materials.

## 5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

# Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

# Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 1 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 2 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

## Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

### Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 1 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 2 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

#### Legal basis

Royal Decree 1540/2011, of October 31st, by which three professional certificates of the professional family "Glass and ceramics", included in the National Repertoire of professional certificates are established. (Appendix I, Code: VICI0110)



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### 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

**Additional information:** Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
