PARTIAL SKILLS VALIDATION

These micro-credentials are the elementary offer of the Vocational Education and Training System. As in B and C Grades, they are a partial and cumulative offer. Each partial skills validation may include one or more units of competence of a VET module included in the Modular Vocational Training Catalogue.



CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCE

Partial and cumulative offer. Each certificate of competence is equivalent to a VET module included in the Modular Vocational Training Catalogue. A certificate of competence (B1, B2 or B3 Grades) can be obtained by accumulating several partial skills validations (A Grades).



C Grades

PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATE

Partial and cumulative offer, consisting of several vocational modules of the Modular Vocational Training Catalogue. Relevant skills for the labour market are acquired. A professional certificate (C1, C2 or C3 Grades) can be obtained by accumulating several certificates of competence (B Grades).



D Grades

VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING GRADES (BASIC, INTERMEDIATE AND HIGHER)

They conform the main offer of the Vocational Training System. They are module-based and their offer is based on the National Catalogue of Skills and the Modular Vocational Training Catalogue. A Basic Technician (D1), Technician (D2) and/or Higher Technician (D3) VET diploma can be obtained by accumulating several professional certificates (C Grades).




E Grades

SPECIALISATION COURSES

Courses that complement and provide a deeper knowledge of professional skills. For those who already hold a Technician (D2) or Higher Technician (D3) VET diploma or for other people who want to take these courses without a previous VET diploma. In the latter case, they must fulfil different entry requirements (different qualifications, skills assessment entry test and/or work experience), depending on each course. After successfully completing a specialisation course, a Specialist Diploma or VET Master Diploma is awarded. These diplomas facilitate labour market insertion and access to university education.

All Grades are divided in three levels of professional competence (1, 2 and 3), as stated in the National Catalogue of Skills, except E Grades, which are only divided in levels 2 and 3.






ROAD MAP OF TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES IN
